

Friendship Community Group Board of Directors Meeting Minutes October 11, 2023

The Friendship Community Group had its October 2023 meeting in person at the Pittsburgh Glass Center on the evening of October 11, 2023. A quorum was present. - Sara made a motion to approve consent agenda items (September 2023 minutes, September Treasurer's Report and September Zoning and Development Committee Meeting minutes). All in favor.

- 5. Sara mentioned updating the Baum Grove signage with something about garbage and no alcohol without express permission and no visible intoxication. Denise suggested talking with Aldi about wall lighting as their wall is a boundary for Baum Grove.
- 6. The wreath sale was brought up. It usually takes place the first Friday in December. After some discussion, the pickup of wreaths will take place on December 2 from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m.
- 7. For the Halloween Stroll, Aafke will help with that.
